

**STANDING ORDER REGARDING REQUIRED ATTACHMENT  
TO MOTIONS FOR RELIEF FROM STAY**

In order to avoid numerous continued hearing regarding payments made and received post-petition,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that any motion for relief from stay alleging a default in payments filed in the Lafayette/Opelousas or Lake Charles Divisions, on or after June 1, 2007, shall include a statement identifying post-petition payments received by the movant. This statement shall contain **ONLY** a listing of each payment received post-petition and the date of receipt of each such payment. This statement can be included in the body of the motion or as an attachment to the motion. The statement should be in the following general format:

Date Received	Amount Received

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the court will not hold a hearing on any motion for relief from stay which does not comply with this order. The court may deny any motion which does not comply with this order and may impose further sanctions as may be warranted.
