Chapter 13 Confirmation Order Noticing Effective December 1, 2020

Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002(f)(7) was amended December 1, 2020, to require that debtors, all creditors, and indenture trustees be given notice of entry of Chapter 13 confirmation orders. The Clerk, or “some other person as the court may direct,” is to give the notice.

Pursuant to the Court’s Local Bankruptcy Rule 2002-1(e)(4), the notice required by subdivision (f)(7) of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002 shall be served by the proponent of the confirmed plan. In addition, Local Bankruptcy Rule 2002-1(h) addresses the filing of a certificate of service when noticed by a party. When a party other than the Bankruptcy Clerk is required by this rule to serve notice, such party shall file a copy of the notice with a certificate of service evidencing the names and addresses of the parties served and the date and manner of service.

The Clerk’s office will notice Chapter 13 confirmation orders to the debtors, all creditors, and indenture trustees beginning December 1, 2020, through January 3, 2021.

Effective January 4, 2021, debtors and debtor’s counsel will be required to provide notice of Chapter 13 confirmation orders to all creditors and to follow up with the filing of a Certificate of Service in the record for each one. The court will continue providing notice to the debtors, debtor’s counsel, and trustees.
