**MODIFICATION OF ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTOCOLS FOR
COURT OPERATIONS DURING THE COVID-19
PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

1. The Court extends the “Protocol Period” as defined in the Order Establishing Protocols for Court Operations During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (adopted by General Order 2020-3) through June 30, 2020, subject to the modifications in this Order.

2. Unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judge, telephone participation will be allowed at all hearings during the Protocol Period.

3. At the presiding judge’s discretion, personal attendance will be permitted at certain hearings during the Protocol Period, and the presiding judge will provide notice with respect to the procedures to be followed in such hearings (i.e. whether masks will be required, courtroom capacity, spacing requirements, etc.).

4. The Protocol Period will terminate on June 30, 2020. Each presiding judge will establish procedures and guidelines for conducting hearings and trials in their respective divisions following the termination of the Protocol Period.
