ORDER CONCERNING STATUTORY AND RULE BASED
DEADLINES DURING THE PROTOCOL PERIOD

On March 15, 2020, this Court entered General Order 2020-3 Establishing Protocols for Court Operations During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, which is effective from March 15, 2020 until further order of the Court (the "Protocol Period"). Under General Order 2020-3, all statutory and other deadlines were left unchanged. The Court now finds it necessary to toll certain deadlines during the Protocol Period.

Therefore, it is ordered that deadlines during the Protocol Period will be handled as follows:

- A. Statutory Deadlines – All statutory deadlines shall remain in effect.
- B. Other Deadlines – Unless otherwise Ordered by the presiding Judge in a specific case following the entry of this Order, all Court-imposed deadlines, all deadlines imposed by local rule, and all deadlines imposed by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure are tolled for the Protocol Period. The tolled deadline will be computed by adding the numbers of days in the Protocol Period to the original deadline. For example, if a deadline is June 22, 2020, and the Protocol Period runs from June 19, 2020 through June 24, 2020, the new deadline is June 29, 2020 (accounting for the fact that the new deadline would expire on a weekend, so the deadline is extended through the following Monday).
