GENERAL ORDER CONCERNING ACCESSIBILITY OF THE CLERK'S OFFICE FOR CASES IN THE LAKE CHARLES DIVISION

On September 2, 2020, the Court entered General Order 2020-7 concerning Hurricane

Laura. Among other things, the order declared, in Section 1:

1. <u>Inaccessibility of Lake Charles clerk's office</u>. For cases assigned to the Lake Charles Division of this Court, and for purposes of Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a)(3) only, the Clerk's Office and the CM/ECF filing system are declared to be inaccessible from Thursday, August 27, 2020 until further order of this Court. Self-represented parties in cases assigned to the Lake Charles Division are granted an extension of time within which to file papers in person through and including November 30, 2020.

Pursuant to this provision, deadlines have remained suspended for cases in the Lake

Charles division. Based on communications with Court personnel and the Lake Charles bar, it

appears that both the Court and the bar will soon be able to resume normal operations. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk's Office and the CM/ECF filing system are declared to be accessible beginning on November 30, 2020 for purposes of Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a)(3). All deadlines which fell during the period of inaccessibility shall be deemed to fall on December 1, 2020.
