IN RE: GENERAL ORDER REGARDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF CASES IN THE MONROE DIVISION

The present order supercedes the order entered by the court on December 18, 2009. With respect to the assignment of cases in the Monroe Division,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that,

- (1) all cases filed under or converted to chapter 13 of the Bankruptcy Code in the Monroe Division on or after February 1, 2010 will be assigned to Judge Henley A. Hunter;
- (2) all pending chapter 13 cases in the Monroe Division will be re-assigned to Judge Hunter effective March 29, 2010 except for cases in which Judge Hunter has previously entered orders recusing himself;
- (3) Judge Robert Summerhays will be assigned all adversary proceedings pending and filed in the Monroe Division effective November 1, 2009;
- (4) all cases filed under or converted to chapter 7 and chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the Monroe Division on or after February 1, 2010 will be assigned to Judge Stephen V. Callaway;

- (5) all pending chapter 7 and chapter 11 cases in the Monroe Division will be re-assigned to Judge Callaway effective March 29, 2010 except for cases in which Judge Callaway has previously entered orders recusing himself; and
- (6) Judge Callaway will continue to hear all cases filed in the Monroe Division under chapter 12 of the Bankruptcy Code.
