

STANDING ORDER RELATING TO ELECTRONIC CASE FILING

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5(e) and Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 5005(a)(2), 9011, and 9029 authorize this court to establish practices and procedures for the filing, signing, and verification of pleadings and papers by electronic means. The court has reviewed the proposed Administrative Procedures for Filing, Signing and Verifying Pleadings and Papers by Electronic Means.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Administrative Procedures for Filing, Signing and Verifying Pleadings and Papers by Electronic Means in this court, including the procedure for registration of attorneys and for distribution of passwords to permit electronic filing and notice of pleadings, and other papers, are hereby approved by the court.

The provisions of this order shall apply to all cases and proceedings presently pending or subsequently filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Louisiana. Amendments to this order may be entered from time to time in keeping with the needs of the court.

This order becomes effective the date the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court may designate by Notice as the "Live Date."
