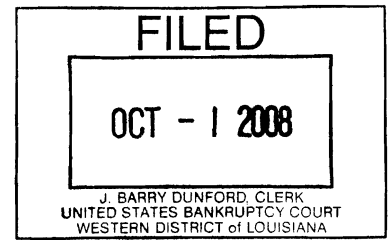

**NOTICE AND ORDER OF REPEAL AND SUNSET DATE OF GENERAL ORDER  
REGARDING ADOPTION OF INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULES  
REGARDING THE BANKRUPTCY ABUSE PROTECTION AND  
CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT OF 2005**

Whereas on April 20, 2005, the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the Act) was enacted into law, and that most provisions of the same became effective on October 17, 2005; and

Whereas the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules prepared Interim Rules designed to implement the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the Act, pending the study of the Act and the drafting and adoption of rule amendments and new rules implementing the same by the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules; and

Whereas this Court adopted the Interim Bankruptcy Rules by General Order to be effective October 17, 2005, to remain in effect until further order of the Court; and


Whereas the following new rules and Amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure effectively implement the substantive and procedural changes to the Act and will supersede the Interim Rules previously adopted by the Court by its General Order, effective December 1, 2008, unless Congress acts to the contrary:

Bankruptcy Rules 1005, 1006, 1007, 1009, 1010, 1011, 1015, 1017, 1019, 1020, 2002, 2003, 2007.1, 2015, 3002, 3003, 3016, 3017.1, 3019, 4002, 4003, 4004, 4006, 4007, 4008, 5001, 5003, 6004, 7012, 7022, 7023.1, 8001, 8003, 9006, 9009, and 9024, and new Bankruptcy Rules 1021, 2007.2, 2015.1, 2015.2, 2015.3, 5008, and 6011.


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2071, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Interim Rules previously adopted in their entirety by this Court's prior General Order shall sunset and shall effectively be repealed effective December 1, 2008, without further notice, with the exception of

Interim Rule 5012 (Communication of and Cooperation with Foreign Courts and Foreign Representatives), which shall remain in effect pending its replacement by a permanent national rule, and further Order of the Court.


